

## DIY instructions:

### Turning a cardboard box into a foosball table



#### This is what you need:

- 1 SEW-EURODRIVE cardboard box
- Green felt
- 14 clothespins
- 12 washers
- 6 wooden dowels
- 6 stoppers
- 1 game ball
- Parcel tape
- Duct tape
- Superglue
- Cutter
- Pencil
- White marker

#### How to build the foosball table

Tape the bottom side of the cardboard box using the parcel tape. Then carefully cut all protruding parts with the cutter and ...



#### Cutting the goals

... cut out one goal on each side of the box (in the middle of the smaller wall).

### Fastening the wooden dowels

Now you have to cut the holes for the dowels. To define the position of the two outer dowels, use a clothespin to determine the distance to the bottom and to the goal (leave enough clearance for the clothespin). You can apply these dimensions to the opposite side

of the box as well. Use a pencil to draw an aid line between the two outer dowels and mark 4 additional holes that are distributed evenly between the outer dowels.

Repeat this step on the other side of the box.

Use the dowels to widen the holes.

### Reinforcing holes

Use the washers to reinforce the holes to avoid tearing. Carefully apply the superglue to do so.

### Coating the inside of the box

Cut the felt material to the size of the box and use the white marker to draw the field markings on the felt. Carefully place the felt into the box.

### Handles

For the handles, wrap duct tape around the ends of the dowels.



---

### Mounting the dowels

Push the dowels through the holes in the box. On each side, start with the first hole next to the goal. Place one dowel into every second hole.



To prevent the dowels from being pulled out in the heat of the moment, place small stoppers on the free ends (for example plastic caps or use playdough).

### Painting and fastening the players

Paint 7 clothespins in the color of your favorite team and 7 others in a second team color. Use some glue to fasten the players to the dowels. If you like, you can now decorate the box on the inside and outside and then start playing. Enjoy!
